

RECOMMENDED BOATING USE

Penstock and Little Pine Lagoons

To help protect sensitive weed beds and reduce turbidity trim your engine to avoid contact with the bottom

Penstock Lagoon

A 50m wide corridor has been established on the lagoon for petrol outboard boats.

The corridor is marked by white buoys and runs from the end of the boating channel down the centre of the lagoon to the Lily Ponds at the southern end.

It is recommended that boating under petrol power be restricted to this 50m wide corridor defined by imaginary lines 25m either side of the line of buoys. Outside of this corridor it is recommended that only electric or manual power be used.

A 5 Knot, no wake, speed limit applies across the whole of the lagoon.

It is recommended that petrol outboard boats used on the lagoon be 5m or less in length and consideration be given to using 4 stroke or low emission 2 stroke motors.



Little Pine Lagoon

A line of white buoys has been established on a line north east of Bertrams Island across to the north west shore.

North of this line it is recommended that only electric or manual power be used.

A 5 Knot, no wake, speed limit applies across the whole of the lagoon.

It is recommended that petrol outboard boats used on the lagoon be 5m or less in length and consideration be given to using 4 stroke or low emission 2 stroke motors.
