

Tarraleah maintenance

No.1 Pond lining project



Tarraleah No.1 Pond was constructed in the late 1930s and is part of the conveyance system that diverts water into the Tarraleah penstocks and power station.

What?

We are undertaking maintenance works at Tarraleah No.1 Pond to improve and extend the life of this important asset.

Why?

Water leakage through earth embankment dams is a common occurrence and is generally not a reason for concern, but can increase as the asset ages.

How?

Tarraleah No.1 Pond and affected canals will be temporarily drained.

This will enable a construction crew to install a high-density polyethylene plastic liner over the face of the adjacent spillway embankment and to secure it to the dam.

When?

Starting in February 2020, works are scheduled to be complete by the end of March 2020. During this time public access to Tarraleah No.1 Pond and affected canals will be restricted.

Public access to Tarraleah No. 2 Pond and Mossy Marsh Pond will remain open.
