## **Rules of Contest – Please Read Carefully**

### **Authority**

The contest will be conducted by the Management of White Sands Estate.

### **Qualifications**

The contest is open to boat entries that are registered and seaworthy in compliance with Tasmanian Law.

### **Fishing Rules**

Fishing rules shall be as per the Recreational Sea Fishing Guide 2011-2012.

Species specification:

**Game Fish** – Any tuna species or marlin.

**Scale Fish** – Any edible fish having scales but excluding flathead.

**Flathead** – Any species of flathead.

**The competition is not open to any species of shark.**

### **Boat Ramps**

All vessels must leave from the following boat ramps/marinas: Bicheno through to Binalong Bay inclusive.

White Sands boat ramp and parking will be available.

### **Weighing of Fish**

All fish are to be weighed at the official weigh station from 4.00pm to 6.00pm by the weigh masters nominated for the competition. It is mandatory that all fish are gilled and gutted before being presented for weighing. All fish must be neat and well presented in buckets or bins. For conservation reasons only two fish per category per boat may be weighed.

### **Disposal**

Any offal disposed of in an unacceptable manner will result in disqualification of the offending team from the competition.

### **Venue**

The venue for all weigh in and presentations will be held at the Function Centre, White Sands Estate, 21554 Tasman Highway, Ironhouse Point.

### **Entries**

Entry fees complete with signed entry forms accepted up until 8.00pm Friday 6th April 2012.

### **Fishing Times**

Fishing times will be: Saturday 7th April 2012 7.00am until 3.00pm

The event will transfer to Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2012 if sea conditions do not allow safe launching.

No lines shall be placed in the water before starting time. Any angler playing a fish at the designated finishing time may continue to fight the fish, however, the organisers must be notified immediately by mobile phone.

### **Fishing Boundaries**

All boats must fish within mobile phone range with East Coast of Tasmania between Eddystone Point and Bicheno.

### **Communication**

All vessels are to advise a primary and secondary mobile phone number for hourly contact by the organisers. You will be required to supply GPS position at each hourly contact.

### **Prizes**

Awarding of the prizes is at the sole discretion of the organisation.

Heaviest Game Fish – One pallet of IronHouse Stubbies (48 cartons)

Heaviest Scale Fish – ½ pallet of IronHouse Stubbies (24 cartons)

Heaviest Flathead – ¼ pallet of IronHouse Stubbies (8 cartons)

The organisation reserves the right to reclassify or refuse entry of any individual angler or team, settle all differences and make decisions or variations relating to the conduct of the contest, in all cases their decision shall be final and binding.

### **Protests**

Any protests must be made in writing and handed to the organisers by 6.00pm on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2011.
